

DEATH OF FORMER BARRE MAN.

**James B. Sawyer, Sr., Passed Away at
Brooklyn Hospital.**

James B. Sawyer, sr., a former resident of this city, passed away early Monday morning at the Greenpoint hospital in Brooklyn, New York, after an illness of a week.

The deceased was born in North Conway, N. H., January 12, 1870, where he spent the earlier part of his life.

He was married to Kathleen Glynn of Medford, Mass., in the year 1889. After their marriage they settled in Medford, residing there for fourteen years, then moving to Barre, where he was employed as a foreman for Trow & Holden Co. for seventeen years.

He is survived by two daughters, Mrs. H. W. Austin of Norwalk, Conn., and Mrs. William Anger of Nurnberg, Germany; and a son, James B. Sawyer of Brooklyn, N. Y.; two sisters, Mrs. N. White of Portsmouth, N. H., and Mrs. William Crowley of Westerville, Vt.; one brother, W. E. Sawyer of North Conway, N. H.

Mr. Sawyer was a member of the G. C. I. A.

The body will arrive in Barre Thursday morning to be placed in the vault to await burial early in the spring at the Hope cemetery.
