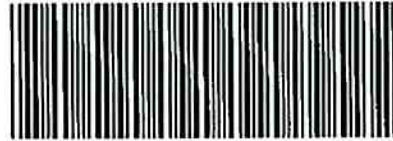

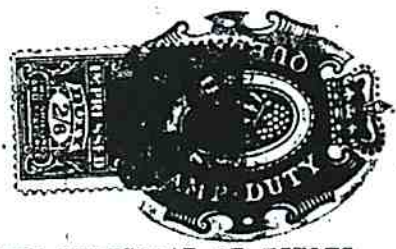


4. — The said lands together with all improvements thereon do not exceed in value the sum of One thousand and sixty eight pounds to the best of my knowledge information and belief.
