


Could be number 35 of 35,33 and 31 Or 19A between 21 and 19, then 19 and 17 or number 3 of 3, 5, and 7

- nothing else seems to fit 20 metres (1chain) by 60 metres (3 chains)

## **Description of Murphy Street St**

## One Rood 8 Perches = 48 perches = 1200 sq m Then in 1975 it was probably split into 2

Commencing on the western side of Murphy Street at the mark at the North Eastern corner of Allotment Numbers five and bounded thence on the east by that street, Northerly One Chain

On the north by the Southern boundary lines of Allotment Numbers seven and eight westerley at right angles to Murphy Street three chains to lane!!!!! (YES it's a Lane!!)

On the west by that lane (TAKE NOTE MURPHY LANE) Southerly, parallel to with Murphy Street One Chain

And on the South by the Northern Boundary lines of Allotments Numbered four and Five Easterly at right angles to Murphy Street three chains to the Point pf Commencement.

Being the Allotment sold as Lot 39 in pursuance of the proclamation of 4<sup>th</sup> March 1861 Being Deed Numbered two thousand four hundred and sixty six (2466)
