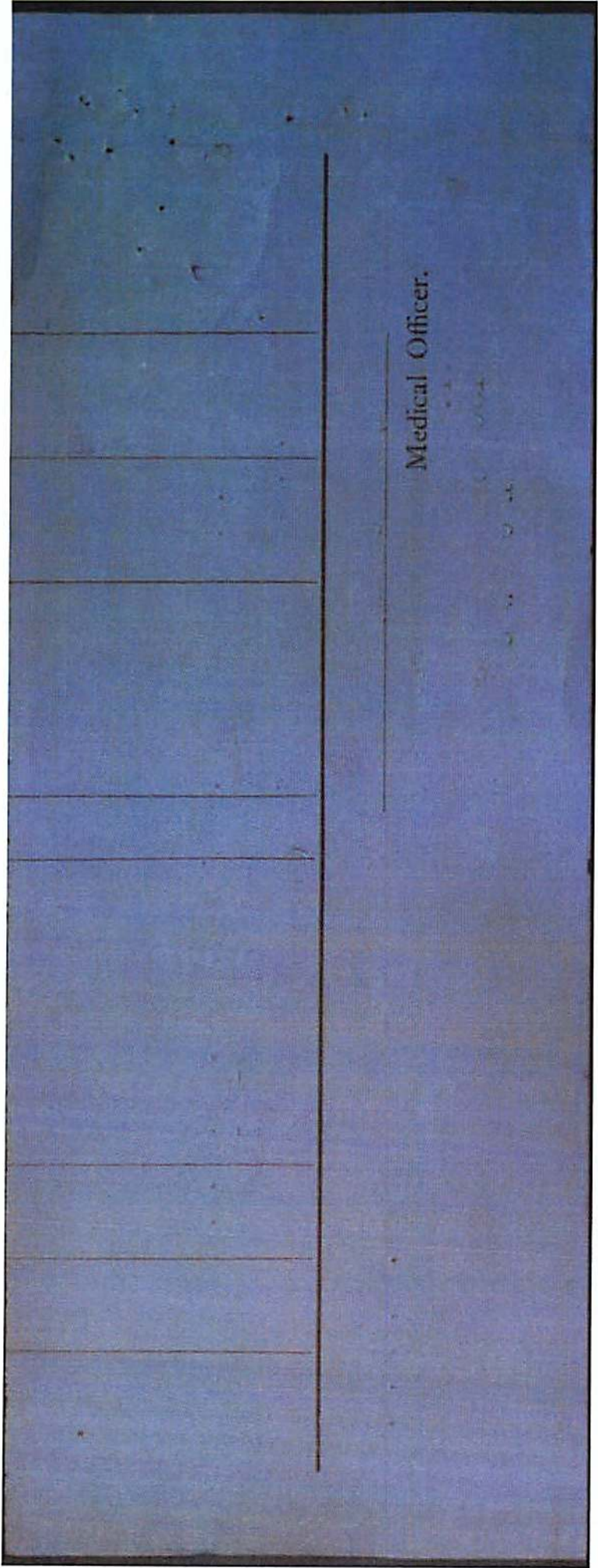

Dear Madam,

With reference to the report of the regrettable loss of your husband, the late No. 3382 Private J. Suthers, 42nd Battalion, I am now in receipt of advice which shows that he died at Borough Isolation Hospital, Weymouth, England, on 6th November, 1917, of cerebral spinal meningitis, and was buried on 8th November, 1917, at Holy Trinity Cemetery, (grave no. 2277, Section "B"), Weymouth, Chaplain A. H. Mitchell, Monte Video Camp, Weymouth, officiating.

The deceased soldier was accorded a military funeral and referring to him Chaplain Mitchell writes -

"The above soldier was known to me. He received every "attention whilst in Hospital and was buried with Military "Honours."

These additional details are furnished by direction, it being the policy of the Department to forward all information received in connection with deaths of members of the Australian Imperial Force.
